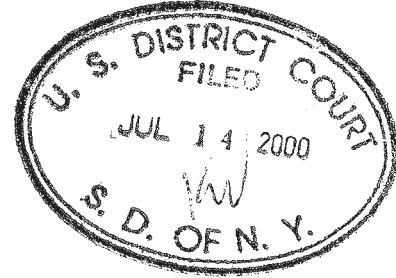

Petitioner, Lloyd's Underwriters (I.C. Agnew and Others Lloyd's Syndicate 672), pursuant to the provisions of the Foreign Sovereign Immunities Act, 28 U.S.C. §§ 1330, 1441 and 1602-1611, the provisions of the Convention on the Recognition and Enforcement of Foreign Arbitral Awards, 21 U.S.T. 2517, T.I.A.S. No. 6997, and the provisions of Section 207 of the Federal Arbitration Act, 9 U.S.C. § 207, having moved for an order confirming the Final Arbitral Award dated November 12, 1998, and directing the entry of a default judgment against Respondents, AO Gazsnabtranzit, AO Moldovagaz and Republic of Moldova, and Respondents, AO Gazsnabtranzit, AO Moldovagaz and Republic of Moldova, having failed to respond to Petitioner's motion, and the Honorable Loretta A.

Preska, United States District Judge, having reviewed Petitioner's papers and, having determined that Petitioner has established its right to relief by evidence satisfactory to the Court, it is therefore:

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Final Arbitral Award dated November 12, 1998, be and hereby is confirmed; and it is further

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Petitioner, Lloyd's Underwriters (I.C. Agnew and Others Lloyd's Syndicate 672), recover from Respondents, AO Gazsnabtranzit, AO Moldovagaz and Republic of Moldova, jointly and severally, the sum of \$8,548,965.00, as provided in the arbitration award, plus post-award prejudgment interest on said sum in the amount of \$1,283,747.64 calculated at the rate of 9% per annum from November 12, 1998 to July 12, 2000, for a subtotal of \$9,832,712.64, plus the reasonable attorneys fees and expenses in the amount of \$30,321.40 incurred by Petitioner, Lloyd's Underwriters (I.C. Agnew and Others Lloyd's Syndicate 672), in bringing its application to confirm the arbitration award, for a grand total of \$9,863,034.04, and it is further

ORDERED that the judgment rendered by the Court on this day in favor of Petitioner and against Respondent be entered as a final judgment, and the Clerk of the Court is directed to enter such judgment forthwith.
